Dear Parents, please note and adhere to the following drop off timings starting Apr 03rd, 2018:

Drop Off:

- 06:30 a.m. to 07:15 a.m. (Early drop off only at BOL- Knights Cove; will require identity check or verification)
- 07:00 a.m. to 07: 30 a.m. (Early drop off only for breakfast at Lambert)
- 07:15 a.m. to 07: 45 a.m. (Regular morning drop off **NO DROP OFF ANYWHERE ON CAMPUS BEFORE 07:15 a.m.** to ensure safety of students)
- 08:00 a.m. to 02:30 p.m. (Gates remain closed; restricted entry, subject to verification)
- 02:30 p.m. Gates open for regular afternoon pick up.

Caution When Exiting the Campus!!

Please exit the Hopkins parking lot with caution, students are crossing to use the Event Center!

Keep in mind, the left lane exiting campus is for left turns ONLY, as it is marked. Please DO NOT use the left lane if you intend to turn right at the light.

We also need your support and co-operation in these two areas: Compliance with use of cell phones and uniform policy!! For the past three quarters, we have been asking our students to adhere to these and we see a trend that students choose to wear whatever they feel like and come to school, this is not the Newman expectations that we have mutually agreed to. Thus please partner with us and help us!!

Non-compliance to Uniform and Grooming Regulations will result in disciplinary action as per school policy.

Use of Cell Phones (Ref: Page 13 of the student handbook)

Use of Cell phones/smart watches at School Premises is Prohibited As abuse of cell phones/smart watches causes distraction, deters the progress of students in curricular and co-curricular activities, and disrupts learning, **cell phones/smart watches must be placed in the backpack and turned off in the school premises. Cell phones/smart watches should not be on the students or carried by them.** During school hours, students must use the school office phone to contact parents for emergency. After school hours, cell phones/smart watches may be used in the school premises only for emergencies, contacting parents, rides, coaches and teachers. Consequences for not upholding this rule will result in disciplinary action leading up to expulsion. The district will not be responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen telecommunication devices.

Uniform Policy (Ref Page: 37-39 of the student handbook)

Uniform Policy Uniforms promote equality among students. Students study and grow well in an environment where there is little or no disparity. Uniforms are an expression of the discipline we are working to instill in our students. Where there is no discipline, there will be no meaningful learning.

Students are required to follow the dress code as outlined in our Uniform Requirement List: This list is located in the school office.

Uniforms must conform to the approved design/style codes and may only be purchased from the authorized vendors (Brooke of Life Hepzi Uniforms (non-profit organization), Kid to Kid) so that students will wear only approved styles and colors. Backpacks must be solid colors with no logos, designs, characters, slogans with the exception of the NIA official logo.

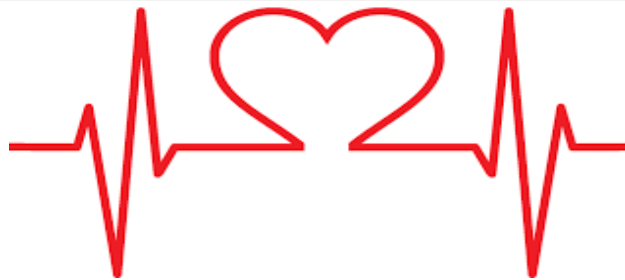
